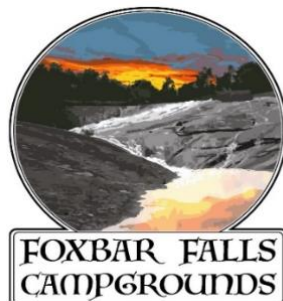

SHORT PROFILE: PAMELA CASSIDY

Pamela Cassidy is a Gold Coast based drama teacher, actor, director, and writer. She holds a Master of Arts in Theatre Studies, and a Licentiate Diploma from the Trinity College, London (Speech and Drama). She is also a Speech and Drama eisteddfod and festival adjudicator, and an examiner for ASCA (The Australian Speech and Communication Association). Her book, *Quirky Scenes for Drama Kings and Queens* is a popular scene book used by drama teachers for class work, eisteddfods, and exams. She is currently working on another collection.

Over the years she has worked extensively in Theatre, TV Commercials, Voice Overs, Television series, and film. Her former theatre company, *Theatrevision* was devoted to the performance of Shakespeare and the classics, and Australian Literature for Young People.
